Dear Prime Minister Trudeau and Minister Fraser,

I'm writing on behalf of SURJ yxe, a group of folks in Saskatchewan that aim to bring more white settlers into racial justice work. We have been organizing since 2020, moving money to Black, Indigenous, and People of Colour organizers and educators in our communities. So far, we have raised over \$10,000 and continue to bring in new supporters and funders from Saskatchewan into this movement.

We stand with the Migrant Rights Network and their national Status for All campaign and we urge you to regularize all undocumented people in the country without exception and ensure that all low-wage migrants in Canada have immediate access to permanent residency. The hundreds of thousands of migrants entering Canada deserve secure housing, jobs, and access to healthcare. These are basic human rights.

As leaders in this country, you have a major choice to make to support the lives of migrants in Canada. If you choose an exclusionary program that gives rights to only a few migrants, you deny so many people and their families these rights and put their lives at risk. We urge you to choose the ethical and just decision by granting equal rights to all migrants by extending permanent residence to 1.7 million migrants, including 500,000 undocumented migrants.

We call on you to implement regularization of all undocumented people without exception and permanent residence for all migrants, particularly those in low-waged jobs. Attached you will find a set of proposals to guide this program, developed by Migrant Rights Network. The folks here at SURJ yxe endorse these proposals and stand in solidarity with the Migrant Rights Network.

The Liberals stand for equality, anti-racism, and believe in welcoming immigrants and refugees to Canada. Implementing this regularization program shows that you truly believe in those principals and that you are willing to stand for the rights of ALL immigrants to Canada. It is time to act now.
