RE: Regularize All Undocumented People and Ensure Permanent Resident Status for All

Dear Prime Minister Trudeau and Minister Miller,

I am writing to you on behalf of 350 Canada to express our strongest possible support for the regularization of all undocumented people, without delay or exception.

350 Canada is the Canadian arm of 350.org, a global climate justice organization that is standing up to the fossil fuel industry and building a clean energy future for all. In Canada, our network includes over 50,000 people from coast-to-coast and we regularly mobilize thousands across the country, in rural communities and city centers.

The climate crisis is upon us, wreaking havoc on communities across the country and around the world. Our immigration policies must meet the urgency of this moment. Differential immigration status facilitates labour exploitation and divides our communities. We all need to pull together to change our economy and society to avert climate disaster, and that requires bringing in those who are currently excluded by immigration laws.

A universal regularization program is also a necessary part of paying off Canada's climate debt. As one of the world's biggest emitters of greenhouse gasses by population, and as home to the headquarters of three quarters of the world's mining companies, Canada is disproportionately responsible for the climate crisis that is worsening global economic inequality, threatening the lives and livelihoods of billions of people, and forcing a massive displacement crisis across the world. We have a moral obligation to welcome climate refugees with open arms – and to take action

Your government has a historic opportunity to stand on the right side of history by granting permanent residency and equal rights to *all* migrants, without caps, restrictions, or barriers. 350 Canada urges you to seize this opportunity with courage and conviction.
